

SOCIETY EXTENDS AWARD CURRENCY

Prince Edward Island

October 20, 2020 – COVID-19 continues to affect the re-opening of aquatic facilities in Prince Edward Island. To help affiliates coordinate the recertification of their instructors and lifeguards when they re-open their facilities, the Lifesaving Society is extending the validity of awards needed for employment until December 31, 2020.

This extension applies only to awards that expired after March 1, 2020 and includes: Standard First Aid, Bronze Cross, National Lifeguard and all Instructor, Examiner and Trainer certifications.

Aquatic employers and employees do not need to take any actions to qualify for the extensions. Lifesaving Society certification cards will not be reprinted.

The Society continues to be guided by the advice of Public Health Agency of Canada and the recommendations of the provincial public health authorities.
